

**BY-LAW #16/18**  
**OF THE**  
**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROCKWOOD**

Being a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Rockwood to set reduced-speed school zone within the municipality, specifically for the Brandt-Argyle Elementary School.

**WHEREAS** Section 98.1 of the Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013 authorize a council to pass by-laws establishing the reduced maximum permitted speed for vehicles being driven on a highway within a school zone within the geographic boundaries of a municipality; and

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Rural Municipality of Rockwood deems it advisable and in the best interests of the Municipality to establish school zones with a reduced maximum speed for vehicles;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Rural Municipality of Rockwood enacts as a By-Law the following:

**1.   *Interpretation***

- 1.1       The By-Law may be called the “Reduced-Speed School Zone By-Law”;
- 1.2       For the purpose of the By-Law, “highway”, “reduced-speed school zone”, “school”, “school property”, “traffic control device”, and “vehicle” have the same meanings as set out in the Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013.

**2.   *Establishment of reduced-speed school zone***

- 2.1       The following portion of the provincial road is designated as reduced-speed school zone with reduced maximum permitted speed:
  - a.       ***Name of School:*** Brandt-Argyle Elementary School  
  
Highway included in the reduced-speed school zone:
    - i.       *That portion of PR 323 (Road 80N) beginning 90 meters west of the school property line and 80 meters east of the school property line;*
    - ii.      *Maximum speed permitted in the Brandt-Argyle Elementary School reduced speed school zone is 30 km/h.*

**3.   *Times when the reduced-speed school zones apply***

The reduced maximum permitted speed established under section 3 apply only from September 1 to June 30, between 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and between Monday to Friday within a reduced-speed school zone.

**4.   *Traffic control devices***

The municipality shall identify a reduced-speed school zone with traffic control devices that comply with the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013.
